Paulo Neto



Paulo Neto is the Head Coach and General Manager of the Baton Rouge Capitals (PDL) and the Head Coach at the University of the Cumberlands (formerly Cumberland College), after being the Assistant Coach of the Men's and Women's Soccer Programs at Lincoln Memorial University. He is also a Head Coach with the

ODP Program (Olympic Development Program) in Kentucky, and regional staff member with ODP Region II.

Before coming to the United States, Neto played in the youth system of some of the best clubs in the world including Fluminense FC and SC Corinthians (Brazil). He also played for the **U-17 Brazilian National Team**.

In the USA, Neto played for Union College and served as Team Captain from 2000 to 2002. In addition to being named Team Captain, Neto was a four-year starter earning All-Conference honors each season including Conference Player of the Year his final season. His various other achievements include, being named All-Region in 2000, 2001, and 2002, and All-American in the same years. Neto graduated with a triple major in Business Administration, Sports Management and Physical Education from Union College, and earned a Masters in Business Administration from LMU. Neto has the USSF "A" License and the Sao Paulo State Soccer Federation (FPF – Brazil). Neto is currently working towards his UEFA "A" License.

Felipe Lawall is the Assistant Coach of the Baton Rouge Capitals (PDL). Felipe grew up playing soccer in Brazil. He started at the age of 4 and played all the way to the professional level in well-known teams such as Palmeiras, Santos and Sao Paulo. He came to the USA in 2001 where he played one season for Union College

being named to the All Conference Team. In 2002 he played for South Georgia College where he was Region XVII MVP and led the nation in goals, assists and points. From 2003-2006 he played for University West Florida where he made All conference, All region and All American teams leading the team to two conference championships (2003 and 2006) one regional championship (2006) and Final 4 appearance in his senior year (2006). In his college career Felipe had 75 goals, 51 assists in 82 games. **In 2007 he was drafted to play for the Orlando Sharks in the Major Indoor Soccer League.** Felipe coaches in USA since 2003 at different ages. He also works in different summer camps throughout the country. Felipe obtained a B.S. degree from UWF (2006) with a major in Physical Education.

About the Camp

In this camp we will accommodate the beginner, the intermediate, and the more advanced players for a week of intense and enjoyable training.

Following the Brazilian philosophy, the fundamentals of the sport are highly emphasized (i.e. dribbling, passing, receiving, finishing, heading, etc).

Also, the players will be instructed on how to improve their speed, quickness, agility, and aggressiveness. To complement our method, small-sided games are extensively used to give players an opportunity to apply the lessons learned in a game situation scenario, and so develop better awareness of the game.

Boys and girls regardless their skill level or experiences are welcome. Participants will be grouped according their age, needs and abilities. Goalkeepers will have specific training during the course of the week.

Discount: Families may receive a \$5.00 discount for each additional child, upon registering another child at regular price.

Requirements: All players are required to wear shinguards at all times, to bring a soccer ball, and to bring their own water. Full-day campers must bring their own lunch.
